NOTICE TO DECLARANTS IN PUBLIC LIFE – ST. KITTS

As the year 2025 has come to a close, all Public Officials who are required to file Declarations with the Integrity Commission, are encouraged to begin organizing their supporting documents. Kindly be reminded that the deadline for submitting your **2025 Declarations of Assets, Liabilities, and Interests** is **April 30, 2026**.

Public officials who resigned, retired, or otherwise demitted office between **January 1 2024 to present**, you are required to file Declarations for a period of up to **two (2) years** following your departure from office.

Please note that **incomplete, unsigned, or unsupported declarations will not be accepted**. Such deficiencies will result in the declaration being treated as **non-filed**. In this regard, all declaration envelopes must remain **unsealed until they are verified during the submission process**.

All Declarants are advised to take note and act in accordance with these requirements.
